
Sweden's industrial workers need:

A strong industrial sector

We need investment in infrastructure – not tax cuts!



We need more homes; home that ordinary people can afford – not exorbitant market rents! Continue to invest in cheap rental properties!

A more secure working life

Industrial workplaces are sometimes dangerous and strenuous. Active work environment management is therefore required to prevent accidents and illness. We want to see increased resources allocated to the Swedish Work Environment Authority and their inspections, and we want access to occupational health services.

When accidents do occur, the police and prosecutors must be swifter and more resolute in dealing with breaches of work environment legislation. It must be prohibitively expensive to cut corners on safety – our lives are at stake!


Industry changes quickly and the expertise of industrial workers must be reinforced in parallel with technological advancements. We therefore wish to see a national system for learning in the workplace. This increased competence will both strengthen industry and increase job security.

A reliable welfare system – across the entire country


